

CoMA MidWinter Composers Course

Tuesday 2nd – Saturday 6th January 2018

Jacqueline du Pré Building, St Hilda's College, Oxford

Treat yourself this New Year to a gigantic creative boost with CoMA's intensive mid-winter **five-day composition course**. With a track record for taking composers onto an entirely new level, the course provides the technical capacity and confidence to realise more ambitious musical ideas and projects.

A **major UK composer will be in residence** offering friendly and supportive advice to composers at all stage of their developments, advice that is nevertheless challenging and deeply instructive. With a focus on string writing, composers are required to write for **amateur strings** as well as for a **professional string trio** that will include **Ruth Gibson** (viola) and **Robin Michael** (cello). One session each day is dedicated to writing as a **composers' ensemble**.

Specifically, the course offers composers

- Pre-course guidance on writing for strings with option to write for amateur mixed ability string orchestra or chamber size string quintet
- Group tuition classes and one-to-one composition tutorials with a leading UK composer
- Attendance at all workshops performing composers' submitted works with feedback by professional performers
- Sessions with a professional trio to inspire and develop new musical ideas
- Working as a 'composers ensemble' to create a collective work for performance
- Right to record all composition sessions
- Concerts in the Jacqueline du Pré Music Building presented by string tutors

St Hilda's is one of the more recently established colleges of Oxford University and located on the banks of the River Cherwell, opposite the Botanic Gardens and Magdalen Bridge with views across the meadows to Christchurch and other colleges. The **Jacqueline du Pré Music Building**, the first purpose-built concert hall in Oxford since the time of Handel, is located within the college grounds. It will accommodate the composers' course and Allcomers' orchestral and quintet sessions, chamber groups and evening concerts.

Fees range from £390 for a day visitor to £645 for full board in a single occupancy room with washbasin (£740 in an ensuite room). There are a limited number of bursaries for full time students offering £140 off the full price. This means that **full time students can attend for as little as £250**. Many colleges have funds to cover course fees.

- 1 Fees paid are for tuition provided by CoMA, and the use of facilities and accommodation provided by St Hilda's College, Oxford.
- 2 Choice of accommodation is subject to availability and will be confirmed separately.
- 3 If you wish to amend your accommodation choice please notify us as soon as possible. We cannot guarantee that all requests will be fulfilled.
- 4 Your place will only be reserved once a completed application form and your deposit or payment in full has been received.
- 5 If we cannot initially offer you a place, we will put your name on the waiting list and hold your payment. We will notify you should a place become available. If you have been put on the waiting list, you may withdraw at any time and your payment, in full, will be returned to you.
